# ASEE International Forum 2018 Call for Posters

The 2018 ASEE International Forum Steering Committee is seeking posters for the 7th Annual ASEE International Forum to be held in conjunction with the 2018 ASEE Annual Conference and Exposition on Wednesday, June 27, 2018, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

The purpose of the International Forum is to bring together engineering professionals from academia and industry from around the globe who are engaged in novel engineering education initiatives to share information on successful models, experiences and best practices. The poster session shall be the concluding event of the Forum, held alongside the President's Farewell Reception from 5.00-7.00PM.

The intention of the poster session is to showcase international activities for the purposes of networking and community building, and to encourage future collaborations. The posters are therefore non-technical in nature: they do not require original research, data, or analysis. The activities presented should therefore either be of value to our audience in their current state, or have clear potential to be developed or replicated. As a result, we encourage diverse approaches to presenting posters, including the involvement of students or students' work and projects if desired.

## **Poster Topics May Include, But Are Not-limited to:**

- Collaborative Student Projects
- Faculty Exchange among International Partners to Enhance Engineering Education
- Classroom Projects on Global Challenges
- Improving Engineering Education in Under-developed Countries
- International Perspectives and Programs on Lifelong Learning
- Issues with Licensing, Accreditation, and Continuing Education in International Arena
- International Collaboration in Online Engineering Programs

## Best Poster Award

Three members of the Forum Steering Committee will form a panel to select the best and second-best posters at the International Forum Poster Session. Selection will be based on a holistic judgment of the posters, taking into consideration the presentation of information, and the originality and impact of the international activity presented.

The winner of the best poster award shall receive a \$200 gift card with the runner up receiving a \$100 award, and both posters shall be highlighted during the President's farewell address.

## Submission

Abstracts should follow the ASEE International Forum Abstract Format guidelines found in the 2018 International Forum Author Kit at <http://international.asee.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/12/2018-International-Forum-Authors-Kit.pdf>. The abstract should be sufficiently complete to enable the Program Committee to determine the poster's suitability for presentation at the International Forum.
